## What do you need to graduate?

### **18 Compulsory Credits**

4 credits in English (1 per grade), 3 credits in mathematics (1 credit in grade 11 or 12), 2 credits in science, 1 credit in Canadian history, 1 credit in Canadian geography, 1 credit in the arts, 1 credit in health and physical education, 1 credit in French as a second language, 0.5 credit in career studies, 0.5 credit in civics.

Plus **one** credit from each of the following groups:

#### Group 1

- English or French as a second language
- a Native language
- a classical or an international language
- · social sciences and humanities
- Canadian and world studies
- Guidance and career education

#### Group 2

- Health and physical education
- The arts
- Business studies
- French as a second language
- Co-op

### Group 3

- Science (grade 11 or 12)
- Technological education
- French as a second language
- Computer studies
- Co-op

In addition to the compulsory credits, students must complete:

- 12 Optional credits
- 40 hours of community involvement activities
- The Ontario Literacy requirement (OSSLT or Ontario Literacy Course)

Elearning Requirement: Any 2 of the above courses must be taken online. Families who wish to opt out of this requirement can submit an opt-out form available in the Student Services office.

## What do you need for French Immersion & Extended French Certificates?

Immersion French Certificate: 4.0 French language credits + an additional 6 credits \* in French (10 total)

Extended French Certificate: 4.0 French language credits + an additional 3 credits \* in French (7 total)

\*Extended and Immersion French courses are denoted with a 3 or 4 at the end of their course code (e.g. AVI203, MPMD3, FEF2D4). These options are listed on the option sheet with the other courses in their subject area.
