**IB and SHSM Program Options in grades 11 & 12:** Students enrolled in IB or SHSM will have additional graduation requirements within their elective choices. Specialized option sheets are available in the KSS student services office.

**All students:** Once you finish planning on this page, you are ready to enter courses via your myblueprint account. Guidance counsellors at KSS will manually review and approve all course requests and will follow up with students/families if there are questions or concerns.

**18 Compulsory Credits**

4 credits in English (1 per grade), 3 credits in mathematics (1 credit in grade 11 or 12), 2 credits in science, 1 credit in Canadian history, 1 credit in Canadian geography, 1 credit in the arts, 1 credit in health and physical education, 1 credit in French as a second language, 0.5 credit in career studies, 0.5 credit in civics.

Plus **one** credit from each of the following groups:

**What do you need for French Immersion & Extended French Certificates?**

Immersion French Certificate: 4.0 French language credits + an additional 6 credits\* in French (10 total)

Extended French Certificate: 4.0 French language credits + an additional 3 credits\* in French (7 total)

*\*Extended and Immersion French courses are denoted with a 3 or 4 at the end of their course code (e.g. AVI203, MPMD3, FEF2D4). These options are listed on the option sheet with the other courses in their subject area.*
